NEW! School Career Development Advisor (SCDA) Training PLU available

Available Spring 2025 & Potentially Summer 2025

This training focuses on: Business Development and Relations, Career Services in the K-12 Sector, and Working as a School Career Development Advisor. SCDA training is a total of 40 hours of instruction and will be facilitated virtually over 6 weeks. Curriculum is developed by NCDA and customized for Alabama educators by Horizon Point. Upon completion of the course, participants are eligible to pursue the Certified School Career Development Advisor (CSCDA) credential.

Facilitating Alabama Career Development (FACD) Training PLU available

Potentially Summer 2025

This training is designed specifically for Alabama educators that have direct and/or indirect ties to career development in K-12 throughout the state. The course will be facilitated virtually over an 8-week period. The course incorporates the 120 hours of content needed to meet the requirements for Facilitating Career Development Training developed by NCDA. Upon successful completion of the course, participants may pursue credentialing through NCDA or CCE.

Professional Development/Continued Education Courses

Available Summer 2025 & Fall 2025

Horizon Point has developed and will continue to develop continuing education courses specifically for ALSDE based on focus group feedback. These courses provide 15-30 hours of CEUs for those who have completed previous FACD cohorts and are working to maintain their 30-75 hours of continuing education every 3 or 5 years (depending on certification) in order to maintain their credential. Potential topics include:

- Workforce Challenges & Solutions in Alabama
- Soft skills (interviewing for jobs, etc.)
- Marketing Your Program/CTE (to include parental connection)
- Alabama Career Planning System (Kuder): Supporting Career Development/Growth
- Build Your K12 CTE (course of Study, curriculum, CTE completer status, etc.)
